**EXHIBITION OF EIS - ST MARYS RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY - 25 DUNHEVED ROAD, ST MARYS**

Reference is made to the Department's referral dated 8 August 2021 with regard to the abovementioned State Significant Development Application (SSDA), which was referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW) Services for comments.

The proposal seeks development approval for the increase of throughput/volume of waste to the existing Resource Recovery Facility under Clause 23 (waste and resource management facilities) of Schedule 1 of the *State Environmental Planning Policy (State and Regional Development)* 2011.

TfNSW has reviewed the Response to Submissions (RtS) Report provided and notes the additional information addressing TfNSW Response to Submission letter. As such, TfNSW has no further comment.

**GTA Peer Review**

It is noted that the proponent has responded to the GTA Peer Review (page 38-45 of the RtS Report). Most of the issues in the GTA Peer Review centre around access and traffic generated on Dunheved Road. As Dunheved Road is a local road, Penrith City Council would be best placed to comment on the GTA Peer Review and response from the proponent. It should be noted that council in their submission on the EIS didn't have any concerns about the traffic generated by the proposal and impacts on Dunheved Road.
