STATE SIGNIFICANT INFRASTRUCTURE (SSI) APPLICATION 7614 – MERIMBULA SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT UPGRADE AND OCEAN OUTFALL - PUBLIC AGENCY CONSULTATION

Dear Mark,

Transport for NSW (TfNSW) refers to the notification it received on 23 August 2021 regarding the above SSI application.

TfNSW has completed an assessment of the information provided and notes:

- the key state classified road is the Princes Highway to which the development has access via the Council managed road network. Arthur Kaine Drive to which the development has direct access and connects to the Princes Highway is an unclassified regional road managed by Council;
- as some of the works proposed as part of this application will affect navigable waters, NSW Maritime has provided comments to TfNSW to enable a combined submission; and
- the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment is seeking comments on the proposal including any recommended conditions.

Having regard for the above, TfNSW will not object to the currently submitted SSI application subject to the conditions outlined in **Attachment 1** being included in any approval issued.

- 1. Prior to the commencement of works a 'Marine Transport Management Plan' is to be provided to NSW Maritime for review and approval, with considerations to be given to:
 - a. Management and establishment of the project area and construction exclusion zone, incorporating any required signage and/or aids to navigation; and
 - b. Communication and engagement with community and stakeholders in relation to the works to be undertaken, including suitable arrangements regarding site access management.

Notes:

- The Marine Transport Management Plan can be emailed to Navsouth@transport.nsw.gov.au for review/approval.
- 2. The mitigation and management measures as detailed in Section 6.0 of the 'Traffic and Transport Report' prepared by AECOM Australia Pty Ltd dated May 2021 and the requirements as detailed in the 'Marine Management Plan' as approved by NSW Maritime shall be implemented for the duration of the development's construction and as required post construction.
- 3. Prior to transporting any oversized or over mass loads, the applicant shall obtain a permit for an oversized and over mass load from the TfNSW Special Permits Unit in Glen Innes. As part of the application, the applicant will need to demonstrate to TfNSW that the arrangements for the route are acceptable and all relevant approvals have been obtained.
