## Request for Advice – Rasp Mine – MOD 6 - New Tailing Storage Facility (MP07\_0018-Mod-6) (Broken Hill City)

Dear Ms Mazaheri,

I refer to your email dated 3 September 2021 inviting advice on the New Tailing Storage Facility for Rasp Mine MP07\_0018 Mod 6.

The following document has been provided and reviewed:

• Rasp Mine Modification Report (Mod6) Kintore Pit TSF3 (RMMR), Broken Hill Operations P/L, August 2021

Two SHR listed items near the site, the *Broken Hill Railway Station and yard group* (SHR 01101) and *BHP Chimney Ruin of First Offices* (SHR 01820) are separated from the works and will not be affected by the proposed modification.

There are no local heritage items affected by this modification as they are not located within the Kintore Pit precinct or the area proposed for the new portal. It is noted that the local heritage items, which are located within the BHP pit, continue to be fenced for protection (Section 8.10, RMMR).

Based on the above information, there are no objections to the proposed modification (MOD6).
