Re: Notice of Exhibition of application for Howlong Sand and Gravel Quarry Expansion (SSD 8804)

Thank you for your referral dated 23 April 2020 inviting comments from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above State Significant Development proposal.

The subject site is not listed on the State Heritage Register (SHR), nor is it in the immediate vicinity of any SHR items. Further, the site does not contain any known historical archaeological deposits. Therefore, no further heritage comments are required. The Department does not need to refer subsequent stages of this proposal to the Heritage Council of NSW.

Heritage NSW worked closely with DPIE in 2019 to establish criteria identifying when an SSD or SSI project should be referred to the Heritage Council.
