Access Logistics Park (SSD-17647189) Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)

I refer to your email of 18 October 2021 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) Water and the Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR) about the above matter.

This proposal is for the construction and operation of a warehouse and distribution centre with a gross floor area of 37,800 m2 of floor space, 170 parking spaces and 16-lot Torrens Title Subdivision.

The following recommendation is provided by NRAR.

Post Approval

Should groundwater be intercepted a Water Access Licence (WAL) under the Water
 Management Act 2000 must be obtained unless the take is less than or equal to 3ML of water
 per year for any aquifer interference activities listed in Clause 7 of Schedule 4 of the Water
 Management (General) Regulation 2018. For more information visit
