RE: New Request for Advice - Mandalong Southern Extension (Mod 10) - Additional longwall (SSD-5144-Mod-10) (Central Coast, Lake Macquarie City)

I refer to your email dated 18 October 2021 inviting recommended consent conditions for the above State Significant Development application for a modification that involves:

Inclusion of a new longwall panel (LW 34)

The following report was considered in our assessment: Mandalong Mine Modification Report for modification to development consent SSD-5144, prepared by EMM, dated October 2021.

As the delegate of the Heritage Council of NSW, I provide the following comments:

- The proposed development would not impact on any SHR items.
- The proposed modification does not alter the Mandalong's development consent boundary.
- The proposed modification is unlikely to have an additional impact beyond those previously assessed.

The following recommended consent condition is developed from an unexpected finds procedure in Appendix 8 – Heritage Impact Assessment of the Statement of Environmental Effects, Mandalong Mine, SSD 5144 - Modification 5, May 2017:

 If, during the course of development works, significant European cultural heritage material is identified, works should cease in that area immediately. Heritage NSW should be notified and works recommenced only when an appropriate and approved management strategy is implemented.
