The following advice for you to consider is from relevant branches of Water.

Please note DPIE - Crown Lands and the Department of Primary Industries advice will be sent in a separate response directly from the relevant areas.

**DPIE – Water and the NSW Natural Resources Access Regulator**

- If any dewatering is required during construction, a site dewatering management plan should be produced in consultation with DPIE Water.
- The proponent should provide information on:
  - Any Impacts of the development on surface and groundwater hydrology and quality.
  - Any water licensing requirements or other approvals required under the *Water Act 1912* or *Water Management Act 2000*.
