Heritage NSW has reviewed the *Eastern Creek Resource Recovery Facility, Addendum Due Diligence Archaeological Assessment, Hanson Construction Materials Pty Ltd, Navin Officer Heritage Consultants Pty Ltd, December 2021*, with respect to Aboriginal cultural heritage as requested.

Heritage NSW understands that this assessment was prepared on behalf of Hanson Construction Materials Pty Ltd (Hanson) in support of a Development Application (DA), that seeks approval for a Resource Recovery Facility at Honeycomb Drive, Eastern Creek. The assessment is an addendum to ERM 2021 report, which found that one AHIMS registered site # 45-5-0556, is located in the wider Hanson project area, which has been heavily disturbed by past and recent land uses and approved development. Heritage NSW notes that AHIMS site # 45-5-0556, is within a reserved conservation area/riparian corridor and will not be impacted by the current project. Heritage NSW supports the recommendation that no further Aboriginal cultural heritage assessment is required, and that the recommendations from ERM 2021 report be implemented.
