**Mandalong Coal Mine MOD 9 Longwall Reorientation

Post Approval

- Creek rehabilitation strategies and mitigation measures for expected and potential creek impacts should be described within a Rehabilitation Management Plan. Any proposed remediation should clearly demonstrate its effectiveness and address the Guidelines for Controlled Activities (available from <https://www.industry.nsw.gov.au/water/licensing-trade/approvals/controlled-activities/guide>). The plan should also present any recommendations for management of further mining-induced subsidence impacts on watercourses.
