ATTACHMENT A

Matters to be considered and addressed:

Planning matters

- i. The proposed outdoor gym space to be defined to ensure the use of this space does not conflict with the pedestrian access adjacent to this area. The use of this space to be restricted to ensure it does not have an adverse impact on the patrons of the retail centre by way of noise, obstructions and viewing.
- ii. The turning circle for the servicing of the supermarket appears to have decreased in size from 27m to 23m in diameter. A review of this is required to ensure adequate manoeuvring area is provided for the largest size trucks proposed to service the supermarket in accordance with the relevant Australian Standards, the minimum being a large rigid truck. If a semi-trailer is unable to be catered for in this area, this must be conditioned on the consent, and sign posted accordingly.
