**Goulburn Poultry Processing Mixed Use Development (SSD 9143) –
EIS Exhibition**

I refer to your email of 18 September 2019 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) – Water about the above matter. The following advice for you to consider is from DPIE – Water and the NSW Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR).

Prior to Project Approval

- Confirmation should be provided by the water supply authority that the volume of water required for the proposal is adequately serviced at the proposed location.
- The proponent should specify the cut depth of the development and identify if a dewatering plan is required in accordance with the NSW Aquifer Interference Policy 2012.
- The proponent should provide details of the maximum capacity of the water storage and confirmation of licensing requirements under water legislation.

Post Project Approval

- The proponent should prepare an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan in consultation with Department of Planning, Industry and Environment Water to manage sediment loads during the construction period and ongoing operation of the site.
