**Re: Notice of Exhibition of modification application for Goulburn Base Hospital Redevelopment (SSD 8667 MOD 2)**

Thank you for your referral dated 14 October 2019 inviting comments from the Heritage Council of NSW on the above State Significant Development proposal.

The subject site is not listed on the State Heritage Register (SHR), nor is it in the immediate vicinity of any SHR items. The historical archaeological assessment for the original proposal indicated that the archaeological potential of the site was limited to footings from the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries and these were of little significance.

Whilst comments have been provided on the original proposal, current practice does not include comments on local heritage items. No further comments are required from the Heritage Council of NSW. However previous comments recommending design modifications to reduce adverse heritage impacts could be referred to by the Department in the assessment of the subject modification application. The Department does not need to refer subsequent stages of this proposal to the Heritage Council of NSW.

As the site contains a local heritage item, and other local items are in the vicinity, advice should be sought from the Goulburn Mulwaree Council.
