Request for Resources Regulator Advice**

I refer to the Department's email dated 15 October 2019 inviting the Resources Regulator to provide advice in relation to the M12 Motorway (SSI-9364) (Fairfield City, Liverpool City, Penrith).

Development Details and Assessment

The M12 Motorway development application proposes:

- Construction and operation of the M12 Motorway, which would run between the M7 Motorway at Cecil Hills and The Northern Road at Luddenham for a distance of about 16 kilometres.

Response

The proposed development is not a mining operation and does not involve the extraction of material classified as a mineral under Schedule 1 of the Mining Regulation 2016.

In addition, the land comprising the proposed development is not the subject of a mining lease granted pursuant to the *Mining Act 1992*.
