## **PROPOSED SECTION 4.55 (2) MODIFICATIONS TO HITCHCOCK ROAD QUARRY**

Reference is made to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) email dated 21 July 2020, regarding the abovementioned application which was referred to Transport for NSW (TfNSW) for comment.

TfNSW has reviewed the submitted documents and requests the following additional information for further assessment:

- 1. TfNSW requests clarification on the location of existing access points to the site from State roads (i.e. Old Northern Road and Wisemans Ferry Road).
- 2. TfNSW requests intersection analysis at the existing access point(s) on State roads. The proponent should investigate the required access arrangement/intersection treatment in compliance with AUSTROADS Guide to Road Design Part 4A:Unsignalised and signalised intersections and the type of right and left turn treatments required (based on the volume of turning traffic versus through traffic).
- 3. The intersection analysis should be provided for both existing and proposed year 2038 scenario.
- 4. Sight distance at the access points should comply with requirements set out in AUSTROADS Guide to Road Design. An assessment should be provided demonstrating the access meets this requirement.
