Subject: Request to waive requirement for BDAR under s7.9 of the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016 – Tahmoor North DA67/98 MOD 5

Thank you for your referral dated 30 July 2020 requesting that the requirement for a biodiversity development assessment report (BDAR) to be submitted with the proposed state significant development modification application DA67/98 MOD 5 is waived.

I have reviewed the information provided by the applicant in the BDAR waiver application dated 3 March 2020 and determined that the proposed development is not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values. The application, therefore, does not need to be accompanied by a BDAR.

The determination is attached for you to provide to the applicant.
