Thank you for consulting the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) to request advice on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the proposed Prospect Logistics Estate (SSD-10399) located at Clunies Ross Street in Prospect and Pemulwuy NSW.

Based on the information provided, the proposal does not require an environment protection licence under the POEO Act. Furthermore, the proposal is not being undertaken by or on behalf of an NSW Public Authority nor are the activities other activities for which the EPA is the appropriate regulatory authority.

In view of these factors, the EPA has no further interest in the proposal and no further consultation is required.
