The Environment, Energy and Science Group (EES) has reviewed the following documents:

- Modification Application Planning Report SSD 9741 MOD 2 September 2020
 - Appendix 8 Landscape Plans 27 August 2020
 - Appendix 9 Landscape Design Report (LDR) issue H 27 August 2020
 - Appendix 12– Biodiversity Development Assessment Repot (BDAR) 10 September 2020
 - Appendix 13 Vegetation Management Plan 11 September 2020
 - Appendix 14 Bushfire Impact Assessment 17 September 2020

and provides the following comments.

Biodiversity

The BDAR (10 September 2020) has not assessed potential biodiversity impacts from the additional works proposed at 2 Apollo Place. While there appears to be no native vegetation at 2 Apollo Place, the buildings may provide habitat for threatened microbats, which may be impacted by the proposed alterations to the building facades, demolition and other works. Therefore, the BDAR should have considered whether there are likely to be any prescribed impacts from works at the site.

Landscaping

The revised LDR for the MOD 2 proposal appears to only apply to the 1 Sirius Road site and not to the additional land at 2 Apollo Place. The proponent needs to clarify whether any revegetation/landscaping is proposed at the 2 Apollo Place site and if so, whether the proposed indigenous plants species which are identified for the APZ and revegetation areas in Section 4 of the revised LDR also apply to the site at 2 Apollo Place (see section 4 of LDR).
