West Nowra landfill Expansion (SSD-7187) (Shoalhaven City) EIS Exhibition

I refer to your email of 25th June 2019 to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) – Lands, Water and Department of Primary Industries (DPI) about the above matter.

The following advice for you to consider is from relevant branches of Lands & Water and DPI.

DPIE – Water and the NSW Natural Resources Access Regulator (NRAR)

The ongoing monitoring and reporting requirements should assess for the risk of hydrostatic
pressure beneath the line. A contingency response plan should be developed to manage this
risk should groundwater levels rise above a nominated threshold(s).

DPI - Agriculture

- It is noted that the proposed development is immediately adjacent to land used for agricultural purposes. There are a range of potential biosecurity and amenity issues that landfill developments can pose on agriculture.
- The proponent should refer to and adopt the suggested management measures outlined in the DPI Agriculture Prime fact titled Agricultural Issues for Landfill Developments https://www.dpi.nsw.gov.au/agriculture/lup/development-assessment2/landfill-developments
