The current wording of the condition does not allow the undertaking of impulsive or tonal noise emitting activities outside of standard construction hours, unless permitted by an EPL. The proposed activities being undertaken by the Line Wide contractor do not trigger the need for an EPL and some activities must be undertaken in a rail possession due to the operational requirements of Northwest Metro and relate to the integration into the existing rail infrastructure network. The requested modification – • is consistent with the assessment provided in the EIS, which stated in Chapter 11.8.1 (page 108) that some works would be required to be undertaken within a rail possession up to 24 hours per day, seven days a week; • provides appropriate flexibility for future activities that may require out of hours work associated with the Line Wide scope of works; and would tie approval of such works into the process outlined in the OOHW Protocol included in the Line Wide CNVMP, which was approved by the Secretary on 16 August 2019.
