Hi Jack,

BCD is satisfied with the response in relation to *Thesium australe* and no further assessment is required.

In relation to Item 2 - BCD requested BAM plot data or appropriate justification. The results of rapid inspections (termed Rapid Data Points) might be suitable appropriate justification. However the rapid inspection data has not been provided for BCD to review. The proponent should provide the rapid inspection data collected from the Exotic Grassland vegetation zones.
