**New Liverpool Primary School (SSD-10391)
Request for additional information**

I refer to the additional information dated 17 February 2022, for the New Liverpool Primary School (SSD-10391). After careful consideration, the Department of Planning and Environment (Department) is requesting that you provide further additional information in relation to flood assessment.

A meeting was held with between the Department staff and Department of Education (DOE) representatives on 4 February 2022. At this meeting, the Department requested DOE to provide the following:

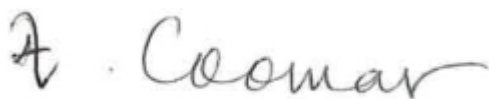
- some examples of other sites within the State, where habitable ground floor level of schools and/or childcare centres have been approved/ constructed below the Probable Maximum Flood (PMF) level.
- outcome of consultation with Liverpool City Council (Council) to establish whether a Flood Emergency Plan is acceptable to Council in lieu of the school buildings being built above the PMF.

The Department notes that the above information have not been submitted as part of the package provided on 17 February 2022. Consequently, the Department requests that the above information be provided to demonstrate that schools have been approved/built in similar scenarios elsewhere in NSW and that Council considers this to be acceptable.

Please provide the information or notify us that the information will not be provided, by Thu 31 March 2022. If you cannot meet this deadline, please provide and commit to an alternative timeframe for providing this information.
