Sydney Metro West - Concept and Stage 1 - Modification 2 (SSI-10038 MOD 2)  
**Request for additional information**

I refer to the Sydney Metro West - Concept and Stage 1 (major civil construction between Westmead and The Bays) Modification 2 (SSI-10038 MOD 2). The Department requires additional information in regard to the proposed realignment of Kay and Unwin streets at the approved Clyde Maintenance and Stabling Facility and its consistency with strategic planning for the area, including draft strategic plans.

The Department is seeking the following:

- how the proposed realignment of Kay and Unwin St is compatible with potential connections, specifically the identified connection between Kay/Unwin Street and the M4 Motorway identified in the *Draft Camellia-Rosehill Place Strategy* (2021), the *Greater Parramatta Interim Land Use and Infrastructure Implementation Plan* (2017), and the *Western Sydney Regional Ring Road Strategy* (2012)
- current designs, drawings, and modelling for the proposed Kay/Unwin Street realignment, including CAD drawings and flood modellings to confirm that a potential M4 connection can be delivered in the next 5 to 10 years, as identified in the *Draft Camellia-Rosehill Place Strategy*.

While the Department acknowledges that a potential connection between Kay/Unwin Street and the M4 Motorway is beyond the scope of Sydney Metro West, the assessment of the proposed modification should consider the ability for infrastructure identified in strategic plans to be delivered in the future.

Please provide the information, or notify us that the information will not be provided, by Fri 08 April 2022. If you cannot meet this deadline, please provide and commit to an alternative timeframe for providing this information.
