



Background

A letter was submitted to the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) in November 2019 requesting the Secretary prepare Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) to accompany the SSD application.

DPIE issued the SEARs on 5 December 2019. Among the requirements is the following:

During the preparation of the EIS, you must consult with the relevant local, State or Commonwealth Government authorities, service providers, community groups, special interest groups, including local Aboriginal land councils and registered Aboriginal stakeholders, and affected landowners. In particular, you must consult with:

- Hawkesbury City Council
- Government Architect NSW (through the NSW SDRP process) (GANSW)
- Transport for NSW (TfNSW)
- Transport for NSW (Roads and Maritime Services) (RMS)
- NSW Rural Fire Service
- Department of Defence Royal Australian Air Force Base Richmond.

Accordingly, we seek to obtain the views of relevant stakeholders and provide them an opportunity to comment on the subject application. We also would welcome the opportunity to meet with you and discuss the proposal in more detail.

An overview of the site and proposal is discussed below.

The Site

The site is located at 177 Grose Vale Road, North Richmond, and is legally defined as Lot 11 DP1134453.

The site is irregular in shape with access handle to Grose Vale Road and has a total area of approximately 9.85ha. A site aerial map and context map are provided below.




Figure 2: Context map

The Proposal

The SSD application will seek approval for the redevelopment of the existing St John of God Richmond Hospital at 177 Gross Vale Road, North Richmond. The SSD will generally include the following:

- Partial demolition of existing facilities;
- Upgrade retained clinical facilities to contemporary, best-practice standards;
- Construct new clinical and support facilities including increased bed capacity from 88 beds to 112 beds;
- Construct new chapel to replace the existing chapel to be demolished; and
- Integrated landscaping.

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

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


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Figure 5: 3D Perspective

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



Hi Addison,

Thanks for the letter and the added detail. We have no objections to the redevelopment in principle, however need to confirm the heights of the ground and buildings:

- ▶ Per page 9 of the request for SEARs (<https://majorprojects.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/prweb/PRRestService/mp/01/getContent?AttachRef=PDA-1122%2120191108T051541.122%20GMT>), the site has a maximum building height of 10 metres marked 'K' on the Height of Buildings Map (I could not however access a map titled Height of building Map when looking through the documents).
- ▶ Request confirmation of the highest building height in meters RL. I note the RL of 62.50m for the ground floor (and 66.50m for the first floor) in the architectural plans <https://majorprojects.planningportal.nsw.gov.au/prweb/PRRestService/mp/01/getContent?AttachRef=PDA-1122%2120191024T034143.878%20GMT>, so the top of the highest building should be no more than 72.50m RL unless I'm misinterpreting the documents. Please confirm that the top of the highest building is no more than 72.50 RL, and of not please advise what it is. Once we have the above, we should be able to provide a final answer.
