I refer to the request to waive the requirement for a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (BDAR) to be submitted with the above State Significant Development Application for revised proposal for Weigall Sports Complex, Sydney Grammar School, Neild Avenue, Rushcutters Bay.

I have reviewed the information provided by the applicant in the BDAR waiver application prepared by Fraser Ecological dated 14 July 2020 and determined that the proposed development is not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values. The application, therefore, does not need to be accompanied by a BDAR.
