Hi Sally,

Thanks for your e mail requesting input to the SEARS for the proposed Simosa Bitumen Facility, Port Kembla.

In addition to the requirements prepared by the DOP hazards team, SWNSW suggests that the following should be addressed in the EIS.

1. The EIS and PHA should identify/outline the safety related measures and controls to be included in the design and operating procedures to ensure that the risk to people are reduced to *So far as is reasonably practicable* to comply with the requirements of the Work Health and Safety(WHS) Act 2011 and Regulation 2017. See Sections 17,18 and 19 of the WHS Act 2011.
2. The proponent should include in the EIS, that the bitumen unloading pipeline and the dangerous good quantities will be notified to the Dangerous Goods and Explosives team of Safework NSW as required under Chapter 7 of the WHS legislation. Clauses 389, 390 and 391 in particular.
