Submissions against Incitec Pivot's proposed ammonium nitrate facility

To the resident

Many Stockton residents will be well aware of Incitec Pivot's proposal to build a second ammonium nitrate plant, next door to Orica's facility on Kooragang Island.

From the outset, Stockton Community Action Group have opposed the proposal due to concerns of explosive risk, noise, air and water pollution and possible impacts to house values.

Incitec have ignored those community concerns and have proceeded to gain regulatory approval. The company's Environmental Impact Statement has been on public exhibition and residents have until October 29 to make a submission against the proposal.
