Centennial Mandalong Pty Limited has submitted a modification application for the Mandalong Southern Extension Project, known as the Mandalong Coal Mine, in the Lake Macquarie and Central Coast local government areas.

The modification application involves:

- extension of an approved longwall panel (LW 24);
- addition of a new longwall panel (LW 24A); and
- extraction of approximately 3.71 million tonnes of additional coal from the new/extended panels.
