1. Subsidence

DPE requests additional information / clarification regarding potential subsidence impacts on transmission towers 45 to 47. Section 5 of the Subsidence Predictions Report concludes that predicted strains would have an adverse impact on transmission towers, and that these impacts require "specific attention". However, no further detail is provided and no further mitigation or management measures have been proposed.

2. Aboriginal Cultural Heritage

DPE requests further information / clarification with respect to the Heritage Impact Assessment. In particular:

- **a.** Table 12 refers to predicted subsidence impacts associated with Longwall 23, rather than Longwalls 24 and 24A, which are the subject of the current modification application.
- **b.** Section 11.2.2 states that there are no identified impacts to the Aboriginal sites and thus no immediate mitigation or management is required. The Department questions the accuracy of this statement, given the predicted subsidence impacts identified in Table 12.

3. Public submissions

The Department notes that two public submissions were received, with one expressing support for the proposed modification and one providing comments. DPE requests that Centennial consider and respond to the issues raised in the latter submission.
