RE: Netball Central, Site 107, Sydney Olympic Park Follow-up to comments upon Director General's Requirements (DGRs)

As you are aware, Netball NSW is preparing a Development Application for the construction of a purpose-built headquarters on the site.

The scope of works includes:

- bulk earthworks and excavation;
- construction of five (5) indoor netball courts of international standard, plus one (1) show court with seating for some 800 spectators;
- amenities and support facilities for players, officials and the public;
- ancillary storage facilities and equipment areas;
- office / administration areas; and
- utility services connections.

The facility is being designed by Scott Carver Architects, having regard to the provisions of Sydney Olympic Park Master Plan 2030 and other relevant SOPA policies and guidelines, including the Guidelines for Outdoor Advertising, Identification and Promotional Signage; the Access Guidelines 2011; the Major Event Impact Assessment Guidelines; the Remediated Lands Management Plan and the Environmental Guidelines for Sydney Olympic Park 2008.

The Department of Planning and Infrastructure has provided a copy of your correspondence dated 28<sup>th</sup> March 2012 in response to its request for input to the Director General's Requirements (DGRs) and we note your comments to date, all of which will be addressed in the documentation submitted in respect of the application. It is our intention to submit the Development Application in early June 2012.
