Where relevant, the The surface of any material proposed to be used for the paving of footways, thoroughfares, plazas and the like which are used by the public must comply with AS/NZS 4586:2004 (including amendments) "Slip resistance classification of new pedestrian surface materials". Details confirming compliance with these requirements must be provided to the Certifying Authority prior to the relevant 109R Certificate being issued.

3. Inserting new Condition B9 in Schedule 2 as shown in *bold italics* as follows:

B9 PROMENADE TREE PLANTING

The tree species to be planted on the foreshore promenade is to be Celtis Australis (Southern Hackberry).
