**Development Approval:** 

**SSD 5589\_2012** granted by the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure on 3 May 2013.

For the following:

The construction and use of a temporary exhibition facility at Glebe Island and White Bay for a maximum period of four (4) year.

**Modification:** 

SSD 5589\_2012 MOD 1: Modification includes:

- The reconfiguration and changes to the design of the prefabricated pavilion style structures to include five interconnecting structures (Exhibitions Halls 01-05) and a separate administration building;
- 26,141sqm of exhibition space and associated facilities and services;
- Changes to car parking, access and servicing arrangements on the Glebe Island portion of the site; and
- Installation and use of generators to power 100% of events.

### **SCHEDULE 2**

1. Condition A2 in Schedule 2 is amended by the insertion of the **bold and italics** words/numbers and deletion of the **struck out** words/numbers as follows:

## **Development in Accordance with Plans and Documents**

A2 The applicant shall carry out the project generally in accordance with the:

- a) Environmental Impact Statement, as amended by the Response to Submissions and the Section 96 Modification Report titled "SSD5589-2012, Glebe Island Expo, Glebe Island and White Bay" dated September 2013 prepared by MG Planning; and
- b) The following drawings, except for:
  - i) any modifications which are Exempt or Complying Development;
  - ii) any modifications as may be necessary for the purpose of compliance with the BCA and any Australian Standards; and
    - iii) otherwise provided by the conditions of this consent.

2. Insert the following new condition as Condition C11:

#### Generators

Prior to the installation of the generators, the applicant is to consult with the EPA regarding any requirement for a Environmental Protection Licence.

3. Insert the following new condition as Condition D11

#### **Generators**

- D11 Certification is to be provided to verify that the generators comply with the following requirements:
  - a. The emissions standards specified in Table 3 of Schedule 4 of the Protection of the Environment Operations (Clean Air) Regulations 2010 for reciprocating internal combustion engines.
  - b. The use of the generators is capable of complying with the operational noise limits established by Condition E1 of the consent and are capable of operating without causing a nuisance.
  - c. The onsite storage and handling of diesel fuel complies with the requirements of Australian Standard AS1940:2004 "Storage and Handling of Flammable and Combustible Liquids".
- 4. Insert the following new condition as Condition D12

#### **Generators**

- D12 Prior to occupation of the premises and where the amount of diesel stored exceeds the following requirements, the applicant is to notify WorkCover NSW of the operation:
  - a. When more than 10,000 litres is stored with other fire risk dangerous goods; or
  - b. When more than 100,000 litres of diesel is stored on its own.

Note: WorkCover NSW may require the preparation of manifests and Emergency Plans to be developed. For additional information and for the applicable placarding/manifest requirements, refer to WorkCover NSW "Storage and Handling of Dangerous Goods Code of Practice 2005".

5. Insert the following new condition as Condition E16

#### **Generators**

- E16 The onsite storage and handling of diesel fuel is to comply with the requirements of Australian Standard AS1940:2004 "Storage and Handling of Flammable and Combustible Liquids.
- 6. Insert the following new condition as Condition E17
  - E17 Generator engine refuelling and servicing operations must be carried out in a manner to ensure the following:
    - a. Any diesel/lubricant spills are contained and appropriately disposed of, without the possibility of drainage into the stormwater system.
    - b. To prevent any diesel/lubricant spills entering Sydney Harbour.
