I would like to object to the modifications being requested on the North Eveleigh Affordable Housing Project at Wilson St Eveleigh.

City West Housing PTY LTD has requested a modification to Condition D1 to extend operation hours to between 6am and midnight.

This is completely unreasonable to neighbouring properties. Sydney City Website states the following:

All potentially noisy work in the city centre must be carried out between 7am and 7pm on weekdays and 7am and 5pm on Saturdays. Construction in all other parts of the local area must take place between 7.30am and 5.30pm Monday to Friday and 7.30am to 3.30pm on Saturday.

as a resident of Wilson St I would like to submit a firm objection. I work in the building industry and do not think that internal works only offers any justification or assurance that noise will be minimal.
