Nathaniel,

As discussed, if you send me the CIV for the project (accompanied by the required QS Report) then I'll send you a fee estimate. The fee estimate includes the application fee, public exhibition fee and the planning reform fee. The fees are based on Section 256C-P of the EP&A Regulations and we advise that you should check our estimate.

The fees are required to be paid shortly after lodgement of your EIS. Once we have confirmed that your EIS is satisfactory and have reviewed your QS report, the Department will send the Applicant an invoice.

I'll confirm the number of copies of the EIS we require for the consistency review early next week.

Please note that the total fees required to be paid may vary in some cases. For instance, if the application is required to be determined by the Planning Assessment Commission (PAC) then an additional fee is required to be paid. Determination by the PAC is required if the applicant has made a political donation, if council objects to the proposal and/or if we receive in excess of 25 submissions.
