Description of proposal

Original Application:

The proposal involves the development of an open cut silver, lead and zinc mine that would extract and process up to 2 million tonnes per annum of ore; and ancillary infrastructure and activities including the realignment of a high voltage power line over the proposed mine site and an approximately 60 km long pipeline to supply water to the mine site.

Amended Application:

The amendment:

- removes the water pipeline from the development application;
- involves changes to the proposed mine site layout and water management; and
- involves a realignment of the high voltage power line

About the exhibition

An exhibition process allows any individual or organisation to have their say about a proposed development.

The Department of Planning and Environment has received an amended application for the abovementioned proposal. The amended application, amendment report and accompanying documents are on exhibition from **Friday 25 March 2022** until **Thursday 7 April 2022**.

At the time of publishing this advertisement, the Minister for Planning has not directed that a public hearing should be held.

The Commonwealth Minister for the Environment has decided the project – known as Bowdens Silver Project (2018/8372) for Commonwealth purposes – is a "controlled action" under the *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act).

These controlled provisions are: Sections 18 and 18A (Listed threatened species and communities)

As the project (2018/8372) will be assessed under the NSW *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979,* this assessment will accord with a bilateral agreement between the NSW and Commonwealth governments made under the EPBC Act. This means the project will be assessed against the requirements of both acts.
