Re: Camden Gas Project Stage 3, Project Application 09_0048

We object to AGL's project application 09_0048 to mine for coal seam gas in Campbelltown and Camden. The reasons for our objection are stated below.

We object AGL drilling because we do not have town water supply and rely on water that is collected in the dam when it rains for our domestic use. We fear that should AGL drill on our property it will poison the water table due to the toxic chemicals that are used in the drilling process. This will result in making our water supply undrinkable and toxic to our health. We also believe that AGL drilling will cause a increase in the salt contents in the water which will adversely affect the quality of pasture and water supply for our cattle.

As you should be aware, there has not been any studies to look at the long term affects of gas drilling which affects the whole biological ecosystem and human health. For this reason, we strongly object to any proposed AGL drilling.
