Camden Gas Project Stage 3 (09 0048) Submissions Report for the Northern Expansion of the Camden Gas Project

I refer to the Submissions Report for the Northern Expansion of the Camden Gas Project that is currently on public exhibition.

The Submissions Report I have submitted to the Department of Planning and Infrastructure regretfully included two typographical errors. These errors and our amendments (set out in tracked changes) are set out below. I would be grateful if the Department could kindly make this letter publicly available in the Department's website further to clause 85B(g) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000 (NSW).

The typographical errors and changes are:

1. Fourth paragraph, first page of the Executive Summary

In response to issues raised in submissions, and as part of AGL's ongoing consultation with stakeholders, it has made amendments to the Northern Expansion Project (referred to as the Amended Project). The Amended Project now includes only 11 well surface locations, being:

- Original well surface locations RA03, RA09, CU02, CU26, CU10, and CU14 and CU29.
- Relocation of two well surface locations, CU06 and CU22;
- Two new well locations, VV03 and CU31.

Well surface locations VV07, VV11 and CU20 have been removed from the Amended Project. The location of associated access tracks and GGLs have also been amended to accommodate new and amended well surface locations.
