Hi,

I live in a quiet little subdivision in Woodville NSW with my family (Pretty much in the middle of where Brandy Hill and Martins Creek Quarries are situated), to let these quarry expansions go ahead is irresponsible and extremely dangerous to the general public, it's OK for the operators of these quarries to say they will be (good little boys) and do the right thing when they get there approvals signed but in the real world blind Freddy can see they just want whatever will make them the most profit. If this expansion gets approved anyone living in these small communities (Brandy Hill, Seaham, Wallalong, Woodville, Paterson can say farewell to their tranquil lifestyle, fully loaded truck and trailers run up and down Butterwick Road from daylight to dusk, Butterwick Road is mine and around 20 other residents only access (turn left of Butterwick Road into Glenurie Close then left into Loch Goyle Drive) into our little slice of heaven, the T-intersection from Glenurie Close onto Butterwick Road has a blind spot on it which restricts your vision to about 70mtrs to the right, the speed limit at the moment on Butterwick Road is 100khr in both directions, to drive out of Glenurie Close onto Butterwick Road while towing a large caravan or trailer is extremely dangerous as these trucks come around this blind corner at 100khr+, there has already been a spate of near misses plus a collision involving 2cars ( one of which had 4 police officers in it), I have written to my state member (Kate Washington) regarding a speed limit reduction on Butterwick Road from 100khr to 80khr, she passed it onto the NSW Government Roads admin over 12mths ago but as yet I have not received a reply from anyone there ( Typical gov response in my opinion, if it doesn't affect them or it's going to cost money they could care less ).

Rest assured if someone gets killed by one of these trucks ( God forbid it's a child ) the local community will let the whole of Australia know how our Government let it happen by giving these expansions to these quarry operators.
