I am a concerned resident residing in Seaham.

The document produced by the quarry is extremely cumbersome and contradicts itself throughout, eg in which direction the expansion will take it mentions east and west?

I have great concern about the constant thumping noise produced by the crusher, the dust fallout and the shaking of the ground when a blast occurs, which has steadily increased over the years and will only get worse if the current production is increased.

A cement crushing operation will only increase the noise and dust currently being produced, which is not good for our health. Rumor has it that they are currently crushing concrete anyway.

There are several creeks that cross over Giles Road, not always running, that pass through dams on several properties that always have water in them and many aquatic species ranging from turtles, yabbies and several species of frogs and possibly fresh water fish can be found in these dams. Several property owners are harvesting bee hives and have livestock grazing.

We moved to the area 10 years ago with the understanding that the quarry had a limited life left and are extremely disappointed that council has renewed the business operations for Hanson for another 30 years. We have concerns about our health and the general ramifications that will exist if this expansion is approved.
