## Forestry Corporation of NSW Submission - Sutton Forest Quarry Project EIS

Forestry Corporation of NSW provides the following comments on the EIS for Sutton Forest Quarries Pty Ltd proposed quarry development, specifically in relation to the interchange on the Hume Highway and the south bound off ramp:

Section 2.8.2.1, detailing plans for the proposed south bound off ramp, identifies
that the bridge approach will be constructed on Lots 11 and 12 DP199557 and Lot
46 DP751284. This land forms part of Penrose State Forest, and Forestry
Corporation will seek just compensation for the land required for the approach
structure.

It is noted that the proposed plan for lengthening the offramp for traffic entering Penrose Forest Way, provides an improvement, by a significant increase in length, compared to the current intersection.

Section 5.17.2 – Kingsbury VC rest area.

Forestry Corporation notes that the EIS identifies significant impact to the current facilities, by the proposed development, and that relocation of the rest area is subject to negotiations with RMS and FCNSW. The rest area is located on Penrose SF and currently managed by FCNSW.
