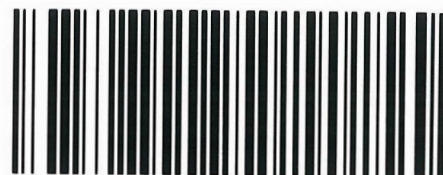
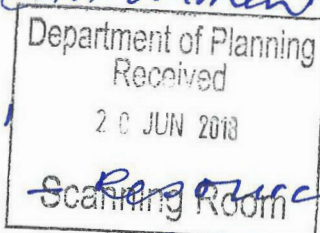

The over-development of this area has
been alarming to watch, particularly
destruction of native vegetation

they are driven onto roads, highways!
Examples: Hume Coal, and now a
very poor and inadequate EIS for
this quarry. A scary prospect.
