#### **EMPLOYMENT**

Sand and gravel quarries employ just a handful of people, perhaps 5-10. This EIS winds this up to 20 and even then half will be admin in a Bondi Junction office.

In the immediate neighbourhood there are at least 30 working people with ordinary jobs and 30 working for commercial water suppliers. These are put in jeopardy if this mine and backfill goes ahead.

The Highlands provides countless employment opportunities through the booming agri-tourism that caters largely for the Sydney market. Penrose Park alone draws at least 25,000 visitors a year to the Highlands. This mine can only damage this industry and employment.

There is no net employment gain down here. Does the Department consider the effects that a destructive mine like this will have on established local employment or just consider the proponents exaggerated figures?
