

## Enquiry details:

I object in the strongest terms to the proposed new sand and sandstone quarry at Sutton Forest. It is an absurd idea to compromise Sydney's drinking water catchment with pollution and sediment and all the other destructive attributes of a quarry. To desecrate over 60 hectares of woodland and farming country for more concrete is environmental vandalism.
