Ref	Commitment
General	
1	The Draft Environmental Management Plans prepared for the Response to PAC Review Report will be reviewed and updated following receipt of Development Consent for the Project to align with the Revised Mine Plan (as relevant).
Noise	
2	KEPCO will consult with landholders whose residences will experience reduced noise impacts as a result of the Revised Mine Plan and associated management and mitigation actions.
Blasting	
3	The Blast Management Plan to be prepared for the Project will include relevant consideration of the management of blasting impacts associated with the former Upper Bylong Catholic Church and Cemetery to be retained under the Revised Mine Plan.
Air Quality	
4	KEPCO supports the EPA's recommended conditions of approval in relation to exhaust emissions standards within any Development Consent conditions for the Project.
Historic Heritage	
5	A Conservation Management Strategy for the former Upper Bylong Catholic Church and Cemetery will be prepared following receipt of Development Consent for the Project.
6	The draft Tarwyn Park and Iron Tank: Conservation Management Plan will be revised and updated to include management measures for the horse burials and amend visual mitigation and management measures for the Revised Mine Plan.
7	Subject to consultation with MWRC and agreement over the need for it at the time, KEPCO will construct, if it is required, an unsealed gravel road between the Upper Bylong Road and Lee Creek Road at mine closure. This road would aim to re-establish the connection between the Upper Bylong Road and with the local road network to the south of the Project.
Aboriginal and Cultural Heritage	
8	Four Aboriginal heritage sites which will not be directly impacted as a result of the Revised Mine Plan will be retained insitu and managed in accordance with the Aboriginal Heritage Management Plan to be prepared for the Project.
Rehabilitation	
9	The Rehabilitation Management Plan will include strategies and methodologies to address the rehabilitation objectives outlined within the existing Recommended Development Consent conditions for the Project.
