Modification to Condition B5 Mechanical Ventilation and Condition F15 Emissions

 Not supported. Council frequently deals with matters arising from the impact of cooking odour, smoke or fumes. No information has been provided by the applicant that supports the 'Approved Methods for the Modelling and Assessment of Air Pollutants in NSW' an appropriate method for assessing these potential impacts.

Modification to Condition F21 Neighbourhood Amenity

• Not supported. The language in this condition is consistent with the submitted Plan of Management (to be updated as per Condition A4).
