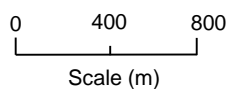

Photograph 1 View south towards proposed quarry from viewpoint along Wybong Rd. Proposed quarry is approximately 2.5km away with minor distant views possible (approximate location indicated by arrow).



Photograph 2 View south-southeast towards proposed quarry from viewpoint along Wybong Rd. Proposed quarry is approximately 2.5km away with minor distant views possible.



Photograph 3 View east-northeast towards proposed quarry from viewpoint along Reedy Creek Rd near Receiver 14. Proposed quarry is approximately 2km away and obscured by vegetation and topography.



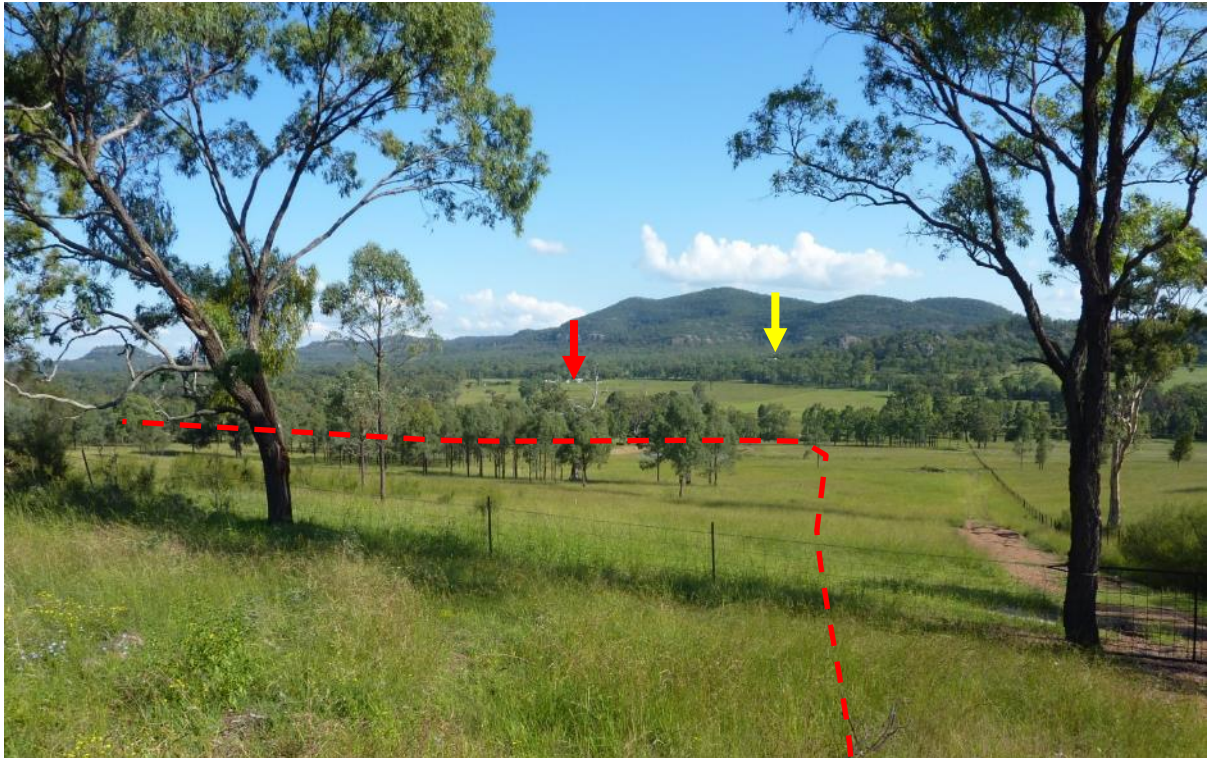

Photograph 13 View east across large licensed dam on “Hollydene” towards quarry in the distance which is obscured by vegetation (red arrow)



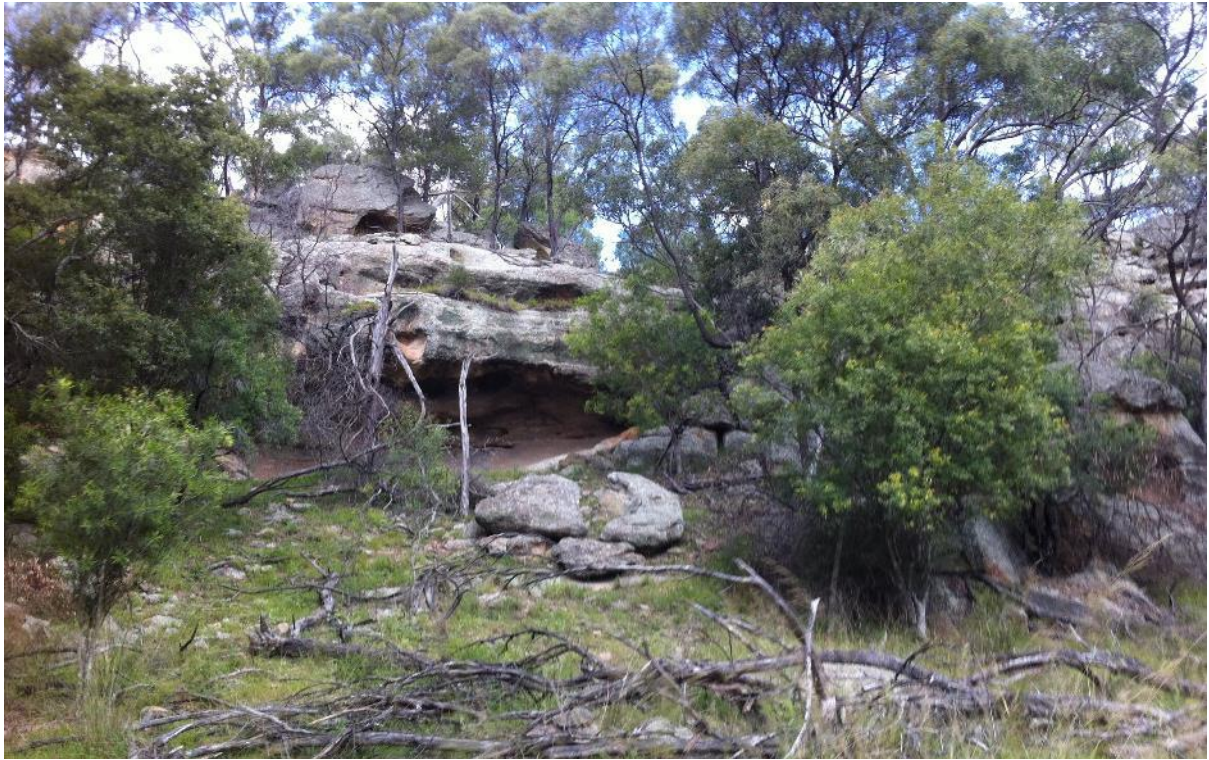
