

The vertical slots are staggered in alternating positions up through the building. The slots provide natural light and ventilation to the common corridors and lift lobbies on each level, whilst allowing views out of the building. These slots also help to conceptually extend the landscape of Bicentennial Park into the building by creating landscaped skygardens which visually extend the park up the building.

The walls of the slots are clad in a printed glass with a pattern by a recognised artist. The smooth surface of the glass helps to reflect light deep into the slots to the common corridors and lift lobbies. Viewed from common corridors, the glass reflects the sky and the vegetation within the slots creating a closer connection with the landscape and the elements.
