Re: Stolthaven Fuel Storage Terminal, Mayfield – Proposed Throughput Increase (SSD 6664 MOD 1)

I refer to your letter dated 15 July 2015 regarding a proposed modification to the approved Stolthaven fuel storage terminal. It is understood that Stolthaven proposes to seek approval for an increase in combustible fuels throughput from 1,010ML to 1,300ML per annum in order to meet market demand.

The Department has considered the proposal as described in your letter and agrees that the application may be considered a minor modification causing minimal environmental impact under section 96(1A) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*.

The Statement of Environmental Effects accompanying your application should include those matters outlined in Clause 115 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000*, including an appropriate level of assessment for all potential environmental impacts, including (but not limited to) air quality, traffic and transport, noise and hazards and risk.
