LANDSCAPE REMEDIATION STRATEGY

CURRENTLY A NUMBER OF PRIVATELY COMMISSIONED GARDENS OCCUPY THIS LANDSCAPED ZONE TOGETHER WITH CAR PARK VENT DUCTS, ACCESS STAIRS TO BASEMENT, PORTE COCHERE DROP OFF AND ENTRY AND OTHER MINOR LANDSCAPE ELEMENTS.
