Modification Application - Erskine Park Resource Management Facility (SSD 7075 MOD 3)

The Department of Planning and Environment (**DP&E**) has referred the Erskine Park Resource Management Facility (**SSD 7075 MOD 3**) Section 96 (1A) modification application to the EPA for comment. The modification proposes adding a sorting line for separating putrescible waste streams at the Premises.

SSD 7075 MOD 3 included The Odour Unit (**TOU**) memorandum *Odour Modelling – Sort Line at Erskine Park Transfer Station: Revised Report* dated 27 August 2018 (the **TOU Memorandum**) which was submitted by the proponent in support of SSD 7075 MOD3. The TOU Memorandum undertook to assess the odour impact that may be caused by the addition of the sort line at the Premises.

On 21 September 2018 EPA provided DP&E comment (**EPA Comment 21 September 2018**) on the TOU Memorandum. The EPA Comment 21 September 2018 queried aspects of the worst-case odour emission rates, the inline odour control units and requested a meeting with the proponent (**Cleanaway**) and DP&E. As a consequence of that meeting Cleanaway has provided clarification to the EPA's questions in *181003.1 Memo for SSD 7075 to Add Basic Sort Line* dated 3 October 2018 (the **Cleanaway Memo 3 October 2018**).

EPA has reviewed the Cleanaway Memo 3 October 2018. The EPA is now able to make an adequate assessment and is satisfied that the EPA's questions regarding the assumed odour emission rates and the odour control units in EPA's Comment 21 September 2018 have been addressed.


Recommendation

The EPA is satisfied that odour emissions from the addition of the manual sort line will be effectively managed by the approved odour containment and treatment measures required in SSD 7075.

The modification works proposed in SSD 7075 MOD 3 do not change the EPA's recommended General Terms of Approval to SSD 7075 (ref: **DOC16/145251**) provided to DP&E on 18 March 2016.
