RE: Response to Submissions for Gunlake Quarry Extension Project SSD 7090.

I refer to your email dated 26 September 2016 inviting a comment on the response to submissions (Rts) on the above State Significant Development application at the Gunlake Quarry Extension.

It is understood that this SSD application seeks to extend the Gunlake Quarry which is situated in Brayton within the Goulburn Mulwarree LGA, NSW. The RtS were provided in a document entitled '*Gunlake Quarry Extension Project Response to Submissions*' prepared for Gunlake Quarries Pty Ltd by EMM, dated September 2016.
